

A proposed set of bus rules and consequences:

A. Rowdy, noisy behavior: turned in seat, legs in aisle, eating, drinking, minor vandalism.

Consequences: Restitution for any vandalism or littering and:

1. Assigned seat for 1-3 days
2. Assigned seat for 3-5 days
3. Assigned seat indefinitely until we see progress
4. Parent conference to set up plan

B. Teasing, name calling, threatening, swearing at someone, serious vandalism, out of seat while bus in motion, throwing small objects at students.

K-2

1. Assigned seat, 1 day
2. Assigned seat, 2 days
3. Assigned seat, 3 days

Grades 3-12:

1. Assigned seat for 3-5 days; restitution for any vandalism
2. Assigned seat indefinitely until we see progress
3. 1 week suspension from bus
4. Parent conference to set up plan

C. hitting, racial/ethnic/sexual harassment or repeated harassment of one student, throwing objects at driver, lighting matches or any flammable material, including cigarettes on bus, other severe or risky behavior, throwing objects out the window, interfering with driver.

K-2

1. Assigned seat, 1 day
2. Assigned seat, 2 days
3. Assigned seat, 3 days

3-5:

1. Assigned seat for 3-5 days
2. Assigned seat indefinitely until we see progress
3. 1 week suspension from bus
4. Parent conference to set up plan

6-12:

1. 1 week suspension from bus
2. 2 week suspension from bus
3. Parent conference to set up plan

Parents K-5 and principal notified for all incidents. At grades 6-12 parents notified at step 2 of level A and B, and step 1 at level C
